A Pre 1950. **B** 1950-58. **C** 1959-67. **D** 1968-76. **E** Post 1976. **M** Marshals (*who may use any make of motorcycle*). Fees are: Pre booked £6.00 (£9.00 on the day), Passenger £3.00 and Marshals £3.00.
 Note: The fee includes a bacon/sausage bap and tea or coffee at the Breakfast Stop.

 I have read the regulations and agree to be bound by them. In consideration for my entry I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the Exeter British Motorcycle Club and the owners or leaseholders of any land used for the meeting and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against any action claims costs and expenses and demands in respect of death or injury to myself or damage to my property, however caused, arising out of or in connection with my entry or my taking part in this meeting and not withstanding that the same may have been contributed or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies their officials, servants, representatives or any agents.
 I declare that whilst taking part in this meeting I have an operative insurance policy in respect of the road traffic act third party and passenger liabilities and my machine/vehicle complies with the requirements of the current law relating to MOT and road fund licences.

START AND FINISH POINT: The Sports Pavilion, Holly Close, Broadclyst, EX5 3JB (*Broadclyst is on the B3181*). From the South, at the Broadclyst Village Sign (*green background*), turn Right at the marked 'Y' junction signposted 'Whimple'. Pass 'Old Coach Road' on the left and then at the sharp right hand bend take the fork to the Left (*Woodbury View*). After 200 yards turn Left into Woodland Road. Follow Woodland Road until you meet Holly Close. From the North, pass through Broadclyst until the signpost for Whimple. Turn left into 'Old Coach Road' and then turn Left and continue on the route above.
 A detailed route card will be available at the start.

SAFETY AND BREAKDOWNS: All entrants and marshals are requested to ride safely and abide by the Highway Code. A safety vehicle will follow up the run as directed by the Chief Marshal. The use of this facility is at the motorcycle rider/owner's risk.

SIGNING ON AND LEAVING THE RUN: On arrival at the start please sign on and collect your 'Run Number'. Please return your run number either at the finish, or if you intend to break off and not complete the run. (*Kindly also inform an official if leaving the run early*).

FACILITIES:

At the start/finish point Tea/Coffee can be obtained for a small donation to charity and toilet facilities are available. Breakfast will be served in the Cullompton Rugby Team Clubhouse where toilet facilities are available. The usual Public House facilities are available at The Anchor Inn Lunch Stop including a carvery lunch if required.
